College In Colorado will award Colorado students who are preparing for the April statewide ACT exam by giving away three \$500 scholarships.

Enter to win by completing one or more sections of the ACT Test Prep on www.CollegelnColorado.org. Send a copy of your summary page from the ACT Test Prep to College In Colorado. The more tests you take, the more times you can enter to win. **The deadline to enter is April 30, 2012.** (You don't have to be a junior to enter. All ages are encouraged to apply.)

How to Enter:

- 1 Go to www.CollegelnColorado.org click on College Planning > Test Prep > Begin Test Prep > ACT.
- 2 Choose one of the ACT practice tests offered and complete all practice questions.
- 3 Once you have completed one of the practice tests click on "Companion Home" under the ACT. This will show you a summary of all the tests you have completed for the ACT Test Prep.
- 4 You will need to create a screen shot of the page and copy it into an e-mail, or print out a copy to send by mail. Make sure to include your **name, address, phone, school, and grade level**.

- 6 By following these steps, you have entered your name for the scholarship drawing. The more practice tests you take on www.CollegelnColorado.org, the more chances to win. Submit all six test prep summaries.

How to create a screen shot and send it in an email:

- 1 Go to the Webpage of your selected screen shot.
- 2 Press the PrtScn or ALT + PrtScn on your keyboard, which is usually located on the top right side. This will create a copy of the page.
- 3 Open a Word document and click "paste" (hold Ctrl and V or go to the menu bar under "edit").
- 4 Your screen shot should appear.
- 5 Save the document and attach to a new e-mail, or you may paste it directly into the e-mail.



TERMS:

ELIGIBILITY AND GENERAL TERMS: Entrants must be legal residents of the United States. Further, entrant registering must be student between the ages of 13-18 residing in Colorado. Residency is subject to verification under Colorado law. Six entries per student. Employees of College In Colorado and CollegenInvest and their immediate family members and members of the same household of such employees are not eligible to win. No substitution of prize is offered, no transfer of prize to a third party is permitted, and prize may not be redeemed for cash value. College In Colorado reserves the right to substitute any prize for one of equal or greater value. Limit one prize per student. Void wherever prohibited or restricted by law. Starter Account Scholarship Prize will be forfeited if the winner does not return the completed Starter Account Scholarship application and any other required documents within 90 days of the winner announcement. No groups, clubs, newsletters or organizations may reproduce or distribute any portion of these rules to their members and anyone who enters this program through means not permitted by these rules is disqualified. All entrants, as a condition of entry, agree to be bound by these official rules and the decisions of College In Colorado, which are final.

WINNER SELECTION, NOTIFICATION, AND ACCOUNT ESTABLISHMENT: All eligible entries received by College In Colorado that are postmarked on or before the deadline for entries of April 30, 2012 will be entered into a random drawing. Three (3) CollegenInvest Starter Account Scholarship winners will be selected at random. Decisions shall be final. Winners will receive notification from College In Colorado via phone and mail. Entrants will receive confirmation of registration via mail accompanied by information about College In Colorado.
